This warranty shall not apply to any **Core Breaker** which has been altered outside the factory in any way so as, in the judgement of AgriMetal, to affect its operation or reliability, or which has been subject to misuse, neglect or accident.

This warranty does not cover parts and accessories which are under separate guarantees from the manufacturers and where service can be obtained from their service facilities. No warranty is extended to regular service items such as lubricants, hoses, paint and the like.


